- a. Virginia Beach MEDAC Chair, Fenton Priest welcomed all, introduced Mayor Bobby Dyer, and asked if he would like to share anything with the group.
- b. Mayor Dyer shared with the group:
 - i. Shared appreciation of MEDAC members and their service
 - ii. Very proud of the Military presence in our community
 - iii. Skillbridge program providing those Vets with training to stay in the area after retirement.
 - iv. OffShore Wind bringing high-tech jobs to help keep graduates here in Hampton Roads.
 - v. Master Plan Mayor Dyer explained the agreement has been signed but discussion on the plan going forward is currently taking place.
 - vi. Kathy Owens shared information on the set tours of the Veteran's Care Centers.
 - vii. Ray White shared information on Industry Day and explained the Navy is planning and ED Staff is assisting.
 - viii. Mayor Dyer shared DOD had a message of urgency to assist with infrastructure which is why they are concentrating on this first plot of land.
 - ix. Craig Quigley added that the Navy is interested in hearing ideas during Industry Day.
 - x. Kathy Owens said she believed a study should be done before decisions are made, and that it doesn't seem fair to all, including adjacent property owners.
 - xi. Fenton Priest reminded the group that the Virginia Beach MEDAC has submitted their letter of support.
