Len informed the group that a Navy E5 is now working in the Auditor's Office for 6 months through the program. This program enables active-duty Military to get the chance to get placed prior to departing their Military Career.

Sultan Camp shared information about the Employment Center he has. Sultan asked if anyone was interested to contract with Service Members to contact him.

Ray White shared information about the new Business Resource Center, The HIVE, which is an endeavor of the City of Virginia Beach to help place both Military and Civilians in the Workforce.

Will Sessoms said he would like to see a central place where all this information can be shared.
